
Before starting your new life with the Lord, it's essential to desire a relationship with Him (a vertical relationship). Imagine yourself as a newborn; you need nourishment to thrive and care to grow. First, you must come to know the Lord, understand His ways, and finally walk in those ways. As you grow, you can disciple others, building a community that helps one another transform into the image of Christ.

Begin to understand the root cause of any addiction.

Science tells us that the root cause of addiction lies within the subconscious mind. Our values, or lack thereof, play a significant role in shaping our life experiences. Scripture explains that it is our sinful nature that drives us towards addiction. However, we now have a new life guided by the Holy Spirit, who leads us through the teachings of the Word. We have the free will to choose which path to follow, in contrast to being previously led by the forces of Satan, which encouraged us to succumb to our sinful nature.

The world serves as our teacher, imparting lessons through life experiences, values, and beliefs. These values and beliefs will be different in country to country and culture to culture.




For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father, b ut is of the world. 1 John 2:16

And all things are of God, who hath reconciled us to himself by Jesus Christ, and hath given to us the ministry of reconcilia tion; 2 Corinthians 5:18




For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works, which God hath before ordained that we should walk in them. Ephesian 2:10




What are your Values?



New Identity

As we develop our new identity, we can expect to face significant challenges. Adversity will arise, and we should be aware that negative influences may still linger in our subconscious. It's normal to experience inner struggles as we strive to fulfill the Lord's purpose for our lives. As mentioned earlier, any new idea that contradicts our former selves will likely encounter resistance.

So, where do we begin? Let's start with the foundational formula: values + beliefs = identity. This is how our identity is shaped within the programming system. Previously, we could see ourselves as akin to the Devil's AI, but now we recognize ourselves as belonging to the Lord, as sons of God. This marks our first acknowledgment of a new life as His children. Our identity is that of a son, and just as Jesus is the Son of God, we are called to reflect Him. Jesus consistently communicated with the Father and submitted His will, saying, "Nevertheless, not my will, but Thine, be done."

Our priority should be to draw closer to the Lord in preparation for the battle ahead. Paul spent many years in seclusion, training to become an instrument of God. Unfortunately, many new believers do not receive adequate guidance. In the Learning Center workbooks, we aim to provide resources that help you understand God's perspective on His creation. This transformation requires significant change, but we have the Holy Spirit as our strength and guide in this new life in Christ.

In the past, we escaped the chaos of life through activities like entertainment, drugs, alcohol, exercise, and vacations. Escape from reality is the hope of mankind. This has been the consequence since the fall of Adam. The angst within ourselves futilely seeks to escape the reality of condemnation. We might not realize this, but it is. The Lord saved us from this so that we may fulfill the purpose of Jesus Christ to reconcile all of creation to Him. Now that we have a Godly perspective through the Holy Spirit. He will teach all things according to His will to help us grow in Him.

Being grounded in your new Identity as a child of God. As infants, we depended on our parents to guide and to care for our needs. In our new life, it is the same. As Jesus sought guidance from the Father, we also need to seek guidance. This will begin with the understanding of His Word. "

His Word is crucial to our growth. As we start, we should take a survey of all scripture. What is the plan of God, and how do I fit into it (Biblical world view book)? We need to renew our minds from the programming of the old ways. Memorization is key. Scriptures says Psalms 119:10-11 "With my whole heart have I sought thee: O let me not wander from thy commandments. Thy word have I hid in mine heart, that I might not sin against thee." Psalms 119: 27 "Make me to understand the way of thy precepts: so shall I talk of thy wondrous works."

As we put into our hearts scripture like this, we can combat those thoughts that have captivated the old way. There will be pushback because the old man will not go down easily.

Find other believers of like-mindedness to be accountable to. As scriptures state,

"Redeeming the time, because the days are evil. Ephesian 5:16

And the peace of God, which passeth all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus. Finally, brethren, whatsoever things are true, whatsoever things are honest, whatsoever things are just, whatsoever things are pure, whatsoever things are lovely, whatsoever things are of good report; if there be any virtue, and if there be any praise, think on these things Philippians 4:7-8
